The Childcare Staff (paid and volunteer) is responsible for the supervision of children during ministry activities, including observing the environment and equipment for unsafe situations, removing children from potentially dangerous conditions, and reporting problems immediately.

The guidelines note that "in communities that are deemed significant mitigation areas by State and local authorities, child care programs should be closed," but that in other areas, programs can "choose to remain open to serve children of essential workers, such as healthcare workers."

- Caregivers should spend minimal time out of the room. Reasons for leaving the room include bathroom breaks, gathering needed supplies, and emergencies.
- All children should have the caregiver's full attention for safety and quality purposes.

Be prepared if your child's school or child care facility is temporarily dismissed. Talk with your employer about sick leave and telework options in case you need to stay home with your child. Consider planning for alternate child care arrangements.

If possible, child care classes should include the same group each day, and the same child care providers should remain with the same group each day. If your child care program remains open, consider creating a separate classroom or group for the children of healthcare workers and other first responders.

Special event childcare is provided for children 6 weeks through 5th grade, but is only provided through age twelve regardless of school grade. A minimum of 10 children is required to open facilities. Childcare is a ministry supplemented by the church budget as a support service of calendared events of CFBC ministries.

Supervision of children. Safety of the building (such as emergency exits, cleanliness and repairs, and potential dangers) Immunizations, handwashing, diapering, and other methods to stop the spread of disease. Nutrition of food served to children.

In the event that an individual involved in the care of children at this <church/temple> becomes aware of suspected abuse or neglect of a child under his/her care, this should be reported immediately to the <IDENTIFY TITLE OF PERSON TO WHOM ABUSE SHOULD BE REPORTED> for further action, including reporting to authorities as may be mandated by state law.

Child Care Program Eligibility. The state's child care system includes several programs, each addressing different child care needs. The California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (CalWORKs) Child Care Program was established in 1997 to provide subsidized services for welfare program participants and low-income families.

Child Care Program Eligibility - California Department of ...

The church has a policy, which it believes is mandated by the Bible, permitting teachers to spank children who misbehave. Ultimately, however, the church's pastor concluded that submitting the child care center to state licensure amounted to a subordination of the center to the secular state
